What is Kent Green Hop Beer?

Kent Green Hop Beer is beer made with fresh, or green, Kentish hops – instead of using hops that have been dried as is more traditional in brewing. The beers have a characteristic fresh taste because the hops used contain many of the oils that are normally lost when hops are dried. Breweries make sure the hops are as fresh as they can be by using them within 12 hours of being picked. This event is one of the largest gathering of Green Hop Beers in the UK!
